GOALS

- 1) Serve as the premier access point of choice for Choctaw owned small businesses to enhance client utility, expand the delivery network of services and provide resources highly valued by clients for operational, financial, marketing and educational needs.
- 2) Effectively communicate programs, services, successes and benefits to current and future clients, stakeholders and community partners to increase awareness and optimize utilization in support of small business growth and entrepreneurship.




SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES


The Chahtapreneur Scholarship was established in 2019 and is funded by donations given to the Chahta Foundation by Choctaw Small Business Development. Funds are raised from a silent auction held annually at the Choctaw Small Business Summit Awards Dinner.


This competitive scholarship is awarded to a Choctaw tribal member pursuing an undergraduate degree in a business field; eligible students must be in their junior or senior year and be residents of Oklahoma. Recipients are awarded \$500 per semester to assist with qualified educational expenses including tuition, fees and course-related expenses such as books, supplies and equipment.


CAVANAL SERVICES



Using breakthrough ideas, process management and exceptional customer service, Cavanal Services is paving the way for innovative and pioneering solutions for onshore outsourcing in the national real estate financial industry. In 2019, Carl Brown moved from California back to his hometown in Poteau, Oklahoma to start a new staffing and fulfillment support business. Since then, Cavanal Services has expanded to three locations, provided remote work opportunities in rural Oklahoma and positively influenced economic development activities within the Choctaw Nation reservation.

Cavanal Services was born from Brown's desire to see fellow Native Americans and others living in Indian Country find success through quality, career-building opportunities. According to Brown, Cavanal Services is a "resume job" for long-term wealth, as employee growth is an important part of Brown's support for entry-level employees. His goal is to train personnel to learn the business, gain valuable experience and use what they learn to leverage more lucrative positions in the future. Brown's unique approach to business has been effective. In 2022, Brown was awarded the Civic Improvement Award from LeFlore County Development Coalition, Choctaw Small Business District 4 Business of the Year and Choctaw Small Business's highest honor, Chahtapreneur of the Year.

AMERICAN RECOVERY PLAN ACT FUNDING TOTAL BY DISTRICT



CHAHTAPRENEUR COWORKING CENTERS



IDABEL CENTER

The Chahtapreneur Co-working Center in Idabel, Oklahoma is located in the newly renovated Idabel Shopping Center. The facility opened in October and offers Choctaw small business owners' access to technology (wi-fi, printer, scanner, photocopier), conference centers, lounge areas and shared or private office space, depending on level of membership. Since opening, the center has hosted over 100 guests, served six full-time businesses and indirectly assisted with creating eight new jobs.

DURANT CENTER _ COMING 2023

The Chahtapreneur Co-working Center in Durant, Oklahoma is currently under renovation and is located in the old Choctaw Nation Headquarters. Scheduled to open in 2023, the state-of-the-art facility will offer the curated community of Choctaw small business owners' access to modern workspace and amenities for technology, innovation and entrepreneurship. The center will have a distinctive mix of basic work necessities combined with exceptional features, including shared and private office space, personal business advising, training workshops, community events and lounge areas with games to help business owners clear their minds after a long day of meaningful work.
