







Austin Hunt DAVIS, OK










This year, Burgess Family Healthcare, located in Valliant, Oklahoma, was granted this esteemed honor.

Established in 2018 by Chabon and Rachel Burgess, Burgess Family Healthcare embodies a commitment to excellence in patient care. Rachel, a family nurse practitioner, pursued her LPN certification at Southeastern Oklahoma State University, followed by a bachelor's degree in science and RN certification from the University of Oklahoma, and furthered her education at Purdue University to earn her APRN credentials.

IDABEL CENTER

The Chahtapreneur Business Center in Idabel, Oklahoma is located in the newly renovated Idabel Shopping Center. The facility, opened in October 2022, offers Choctaw small business owners access to technology (wi-fi, printer, scanner, photocopier), conference centers, lounge areas and shared or private office space, depending on level of membership. Since opening, the center has hosted over 100 guests, served six full-time businesses and indirectly assisted with creating eight new jobs.

DURANT CENTER

The Chahtapreneur Center in Durant, Oklahoma is located in the old Choctaw Nation Headquarters. The center, opened in December 2023, offers the curated community of Choctaw small business owners access to modern workspace and amenities for technology, innovation, and entrepreneurship. The center has a distinctive mix of basic work necessities combined with exceptional features, including shared and private office space, personal business advising, training workshops, community events and lounge areas with games to help business owners clear their minds after a long day of meaningful work.

Choctaw Small Business Development focuses on creating new jobs and promoting economic growth in the communities within the Choctaw Nation. They offer multiple training resources to Choctaw Nation tribal members, along with one-on-one consulting services to give entrepreneurs the opportunity to learn how to start or grow their business successfully. Their work makes a significant economic impact and creates numerous jobs, while also benefiting non-tribal members and businesses in the southeastern part of Oklahoma.
